1. RoHS-Directive 2011/65/EU + delegated directive 2015/863/EU

Directive of the European Parliament and the Council of 08/06/2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

Delegated directive of 31/03/2015 amending Annex II to Directive 2011/65/EU.

Following substances namely are involved:

Lead (Pb) – 0,1%

Mercury (Hg) – 0,1%

Cadmium (Cd) – 0,01%

Hexavalent chromium (Cr) – 0,1%

Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) – 0,1%

Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) – 0,1%

Extension from 31/03/2015 (2015/863/EU):

Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) – 0,1%

Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) – 0,1%

Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) – 0,1%

Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) – 0,1%

The percentual values are the maximum concentration values tolerated by weight in homogeneous materials.

2. RoHS Declaration of Conformity

We hereby declare that our products are RoHS compliant. The exceptions listed in the directive may apply. The marking of RoHS compliant is possible on the shipping documents, the invoices and the labels on the product packaging by customer request.

3. Forbidden ingredients and certification

The statement of the directive is definitely. The statement describes the restriction and the use of the hazardous substances. In Point 1 the exceptions are determined. The legislator requires no certificates, statements, reports or labeling. It refers to principle of the presumption of conformity to avoid unnecessary bureaucracy.
